Let's Work It Out: Intentional Strategies for Addressing HIBT [Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying and Teasing]

Abstract:

Harassment, intimidation, bullying and teasing [HIBT] form a pervasive global problem. Educators at every level, worldwide, contend with it on a daily basis. This workshop will share theoretical underpinnings, and proven strategies, plans and activities developed and utilized by the researcher, her students and colleagues in combating HIBT and forming the peaceful classroom.

Short bio:

Dr. Blythe Hinitz is Distinguished Professor of Elementary and Early Childhood Education at The College of New Jersey, where she teaches courses in Early Childhood Education. Social Studies and Research. She is President of Chapter 208 of the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi; a charter member of the Eleanor Roosevelt Chapter of Kappa Delta Pi [Honor Society] and was named an Exceptional Master Leader by *Exchange* in 2015.

She is a member of the World Organization for Early Childhood Education [OMEP] – U.S. National Committee Board; a Past Chair and current Board member of the Peace Education Special Interest Group [SIG] of the American Educational Research Association [AERA], and she currently serves on the Expert Advisory Group to the NJ Coalition for Bullying Awareness and Prevention.

Professor Hinitz is Past President of the New Jersey Association of Early Childhood Teacher Educators [NJAECTE], and she has been National Treasurer and a multi-term National Board member of NAECTE.. She works with Kidsbridge Tolerance Museum; the Educational Equity Center; the International Standing Conference on the History of Education; and serves as an advocate for the Convention on the Rights of the Child in the USA.
